The parties are directed to exchange the pleadings.
- 7. The Appellant-in-person has prayed for the stay of the impugned Orders dated 27.08.2024 and 25.09.2024. As prayed, the said impugned Orders shall be kept in abeyance till the pendency of the Appeal.
- 8. The Registry is directed to allot regular number to this Appeal and list the matter after the expiry of the aforesaid period.
